

## Scholls Ferry Area Pipeline Project

The Willamette Water Supply Program Scholls Ferry Area Pipeline Project consists of more than seven miles of 66-inch-diameter, welded, steel pipe. The pipeline will be constructed in multiple phases to promote coordination with public and private road improvement projects. Partnering on road projects reduces community and neighborhood impacts by eliminating the need for multiple construction projects. ### North of Beef Bend to Scholls Ferry Roads (PLM 5.1)

The first phase of construction is in partnership with Washington County's Roy Rogers Road widening project from Scholls Ferry south past Bull Mountain Roads. Road construction is scheduled to begin in 2019 with pipeline installation in 2020. Visit [Washington County's website](http://WashingtonCounty's website) for information about road improvements.

### Scholls Ferry to Grabhorn Roads (PLM 5.2)

The second phase of the pipeline will continue north and west, along SW Scholls Ferry Road to Tile Flat Road, and end just north of the Tile Flat and Grabhorn Road intersection. Construction of this section of the pipeline is coordinated with new residential development along Scholls Ferry and Tile Flat Roads. Construction is scheduled to begin in early 2019.

### Grabhorn Road to Farmington Road, via Clark Hill Road (PLM 5.3)

The third phase of the pipeline connects the pipeline along Grabhorn Road to the new water storage tanks on Cooper Mountain. The pipeline then continues west to Clark Hill Road and north to Farmington Road.

Water Supply staff are studying Farmington Road pipeline alignment alternatives to determine if there are options that would require fewer seismic mitigation measures. Design for this section of the pipeline will begin in late 2018. Construction is anticipated in 2022.

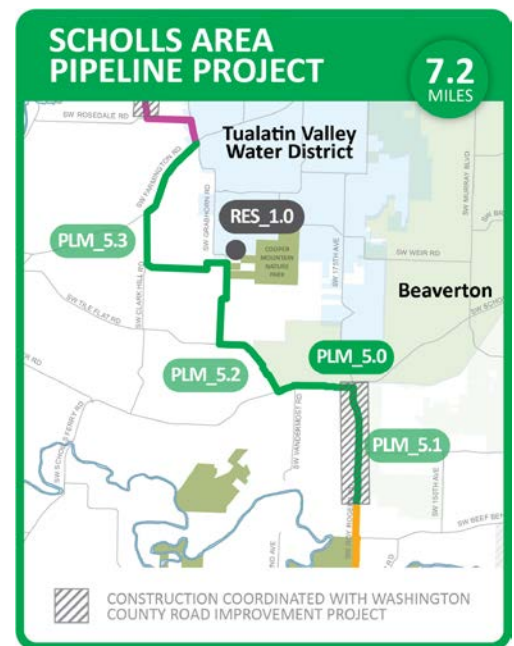

### Our Future Water Supply

The Willamette Water Supply Program is a partnership between Tualatin Valley Water District and the City of Hillsboro to develop the mid-Willamette River at Wilsonville as an additional water supply source. This new system, when operational in 2026, will provide a reliable water supply for the region while also helping water system operators balance supply during times of drought or other supply interruptions, and recover more quickly after a large natural disaster.
