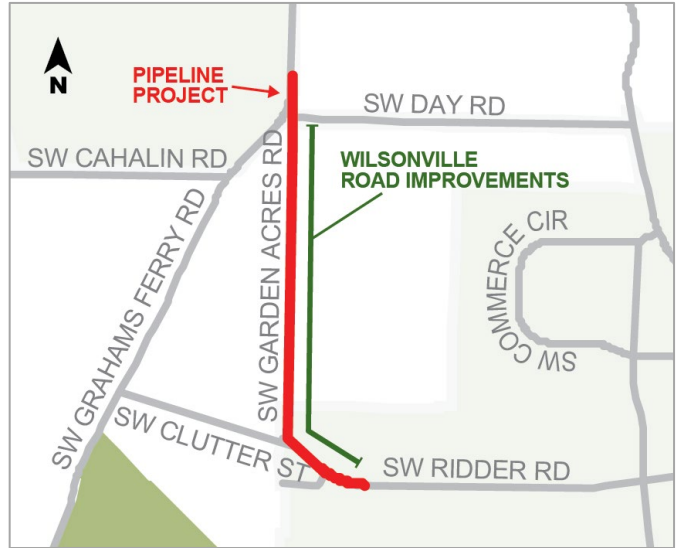


Willamette Water Supply Program / Garden Acres Road Improvements

The City of Wilsonville and Willamette Water Supply Program (WWSP) staff have been coordinating efforts to install a 66-inch water pipeline in conjunction with a scheduled City project to upgrade Garden Acres Road.

Improvements to Garden Acres Road are supporting Wilsonville’s economic development efforts in the future Coffee Creek Industrial Area. A well-coordinated effort to install the water pipeline now reduces construction impacts and saves money through sharing costs.

Tentative Schedule (subject to change)	
Activity	Timeframe
Construction start	June 2019
Construction mobilization - clearing and grading construction area	June–July 2019
Sanitary sewer, storm sewer and franchise utility joint trench Installation	August–October 2019
Franchise utilities relocation and decommission	November–January 2019
WWSP Pipeline Installation	June–November 2020
Garden Acres Road construction complete	January 2021

Our Future Water Supply

Tualatin Valley Water District (TVWD), City of Hillsboro and City of Beaverton are partnering to develop the mid-Willamette River at Wilsonville as an additional water supply source. There is enough water for today—but steps need to be taken now to have an adequate supply to meet future demands and provide greater reliability. The WWSP will design and build a water treatment plant, storage tanks and 30 plus miles of large diameter transmission pipeline.
