

Wilsonville Area Pipeline Project (PLM 1.3) Phase 3

The Willamette Water Supply Program (WWSP) is coordinating with the City of Wilsonville to construct a water pipeline along Wilsonville Road to Garden Acres Road. It will connect the remaining portion of pipeline through Wilsonville that follows SW Kinsman Road, SW Boeckman Road, SW 95th Avenue, and SW Ridder Road.

Construction of the PLM 1.3 pipeline is anticipated to begin in February 2022, with completion in 2024. Construction will occur in phases to enhance safety and minimize traffic, neighborhood, and business disruptions.

Our Future Water Supply

The WWSP is a partnership between Tualatin Valley Water District, the City of Hillsboro and the City of Beaverton to develop the mid-Willamette River at Wilsonville as an additional water supply source and will be paid for by those ratepayers. This new system, when operational in 2026, will provide a reliable water supply for the region while also helping water system operators balance supply during times of drought or other supply interruptions, and recover more quickly after a large natural disaster.
