

Cornelius Pass Road Pipeline Project


Water pipeline construction is anticipated to begin in summer 2021 and continue through late 2024.

The City of Hillsboro is partnering with the Tualatin Valley Water District (TVWD) and the City of Beaverton to develop the mid-Willamette River at Wilsonville as an additional water supply source to meet our community's needs today, in the future, and during emergencies.

A 3.3-mile section of transmission pipeline to supply Hillsboro and TVWD water will be constructed between Frances Street and just south of Highway 26. The project also includes a separate section of local service pipeline for the City of Hillsboro.

The pipeline will be constructed in Cornelius Pass Road, with small sections built outside of the roadway where necessary.

As design and permitting of the pipeline continue, more information will be shared. Route neighbors may receive notices directly from permitting agencies. Willamette Water Supply staff will contact property owners directly if easements are needed.



Our Future Water Supply

The Willamette Water Supply Program is a partnership between the Tualatin Valley Water District, the City of Hillsboro and the City of Beaverton to develop the mid-Willamette River at Wilsonville as an additional water supply source. This new system, when operational in 2026, will provide a reliable water supply for the region by helping water system operators balance supply during times of drought or other supply interruptions, as well as recover more quickly after a large natural disaster.
