Contract Procurement Opportunities

Hoffman Fowler LLC, the Construction Manager/General Contractor (CM/GC) for the Willamette Water Supply Program (WWSP) [Water Storage Tanks and Scholls Area Pipeline \(phase 3\)](#), is promoting several bid opportunities to qualified businesses. Under this approach, Hoffman Fowler LLC will manage overall procurement and construction, with oversight from the WWSP; and may elect to competitively bid as self-performing some portions of the work; including structural concrete (Hoffman Structures) and steel piping (James W. Fowler Company).

Hoffman Fowler has prepared separate bid packages to encourage participation from the local contractor community to bid amongst more than 70+ work categories that will be distributed in six (6) bidding opportunities. Bid documents are anticipated to be available to subcontractors and suppliers for the multiple bidding opportunities as follows:

 - A. Bid Package No. 01--Long Lead Items to Procure early include (bid in August):
 - 1) Steel Pipe Materials for both RES 1.0 and PLM 5.3
 - 2) Associated Butterfly Valves and Appurtenances
 - 3) Precast Vault Structures for PLM 5.3
 - B. Bid Package No. 02—Steel Pipe Installation and Associated Materials--(Self Performed—bid to WWSP). Trenchless work to be under Pipe Installation Subcontractor.
 - C. Bid Package No. 03—Earthwork, Soil Nail Wall and Shotcrete, Paving, Utilities and Process Integration.
 - D. Bid Package No. 04—Ground Improvements (Best Value Approach)
 - E. Bid Package No. 05—Concrete Work (Best Value; Self Performed—bid to WWSP) and Prestressed Concrete.
 - F. Bid Package No. 06—Balance of Work
