
Dear neighbor,

Beginning as early as late December, construction crews performing drinking waterline work for phase 2 of the Metzger Pipeline East Project will temporarily relocate the dedicated westbound SW Scholls Ferry Road turn and bicycle lanes onto northbound SW Cascade Avenue. The turn and bicycle lanes will be merged into the westbound travel lane. **Vehicles and bicycles will share the lane to continue straight or turn north.** The sidewalk on the west side of SW Scholls Ferry Road will also be closed. Pedestrians will be detoured to the sidewalk on the east side of the road. Please see the map on the back of this flyer.

This temporary turn lane and bicycle lane relocation will allow crews to utilize the median and side of the road as a work area to install the drinking water pipeline and tunnel beneath the roads. The turn lane and bike lane relocation are anticipated to last until March. Other upcoming work in Cascade includes installing the 16-inch pipeline that will involve lane closures and driveway coordination for businesses north of SW Scholls Ferry Road.

Please ensure that you, and others in your care, watch for and obey signs that will be posted to alert roadway users about the lane relocations and work area. **Motorists should watch for bicyclists that will be in the roadway in this area.** The work area will be clearly marked with signs, barricades, and other means to help ensure the safety of the public and our workers.

Thank you for your patience during construction on this important seismically resilient drinking water project for the region.
