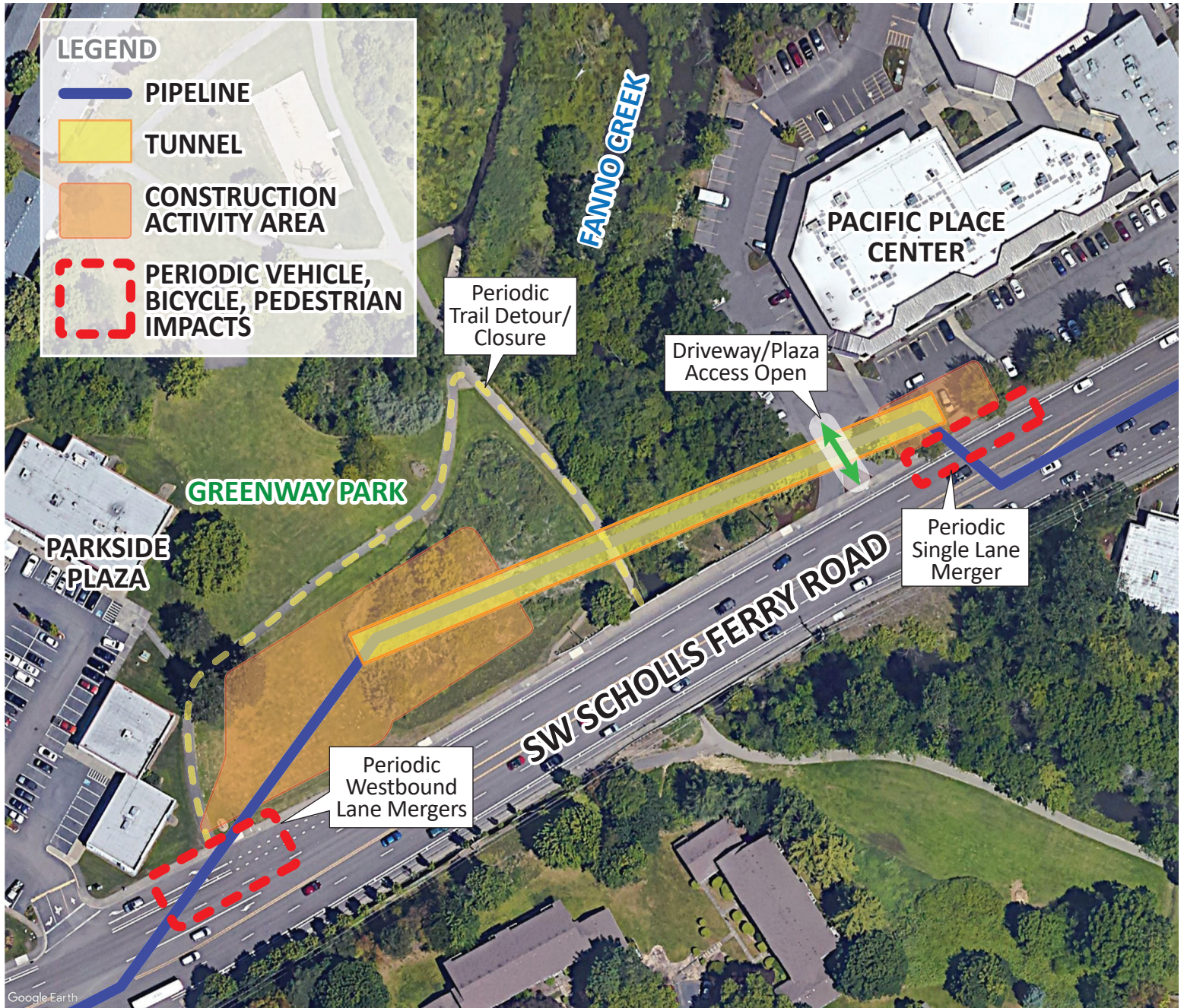


# Pipeline Construction Beginning In and Near Greenway Park

Crews anticipate beginning to utilize a portion of the park in late April next to SW Scholls Ferry Road to install the 48-inch drinking water pipeline and an approximately 28-foot-deep tunnel that will cross beneath Fanno Creek.

The project is closely coordinated with the Tualatin Hills Park & Recreation District (THPRD). Construction will take place in the grassy areas away from wetlands to limit creek and park user impacts. Tunneling is anticipated to take about seven months. Pipeline installation and park restoration will continue through November 2024.

**The Willamette Water Supply System (WWSS) MPE\_1.0** project is a partnership between the Tualatin Valley Water District (TVWD), City of Hillsboro, and City of Beaverton to build a new seismically resilient drinking water system by 2026. The project combines planned improvements by TVWD with WWSS and the City of Beaverton water construction projects. The combined project maximizes cost-effectiveness and reduces community and environmental construction impacts. Those living, traveling, working, and shopping along portions of SW Scholls Ferry Road, SW Hall Boulevard, SW Cascade Avenue, SW Allen Boulevard and Western Avenue can expect various construction activities from the fall of 2021 until the fall of 2024.
