Wilsonville Area Pipeline Project (PLM 1.3)

Project Overview

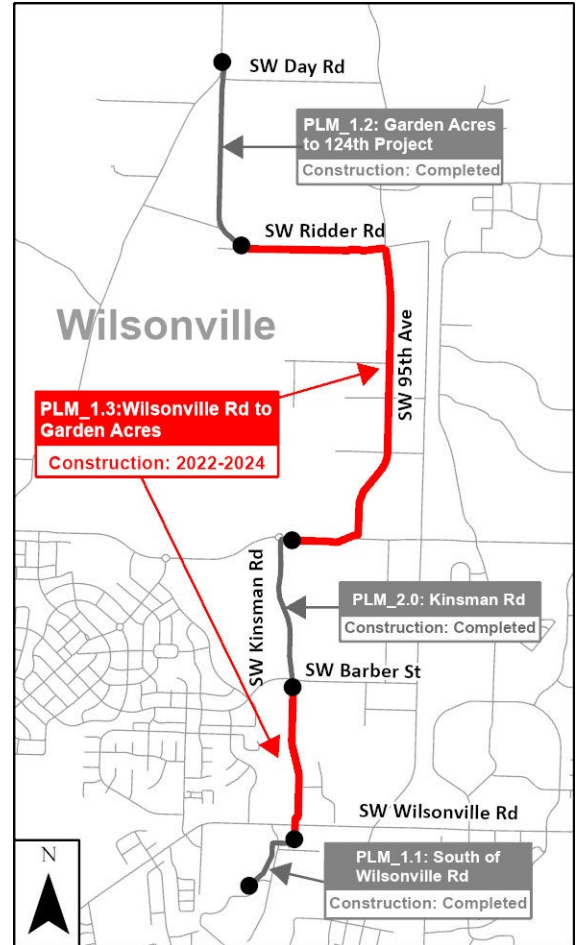
The Willamette Water Supply Program (WWSP) is coordinating with the City of Wilsonville to construct a 66-inch, welded steel water pipeline from Wilsonville Road to Garden Acres Road. It will connect the segments of previously installed pipeline in Wilsonville and its alignment will follow SW Kinsman Road, SW Boeckman Road, SW 95th Avenue, and SW Ridder Road.

Upcoming Construction

Construction of the PLM 1.3 pipeline is anticipated to begin late 2022, with completion in 2024. Construction will occur in two phases to enhance safety and minimize traffic, neighborhood, and business disruptions. Phase 1 will take place between SW Wilsonville Road and SW Barber Street. Followed by Phase 2 between Boeckman Road and SW Ridder Road.

Our Future Water Supply

The WWSP is a partnership between Tualatin Valley Water District, the City of Hillsboro and the City of Beaverton to develop the mid-Willamette River at Wilsonville as an additional water supply source and will be paid for by those ratepayers. This new system, when operational in 2026, will provide a reliable water supply for the region while also helping water system operators balance supply during times of drought or other supply interruptions, and recover more quickly after a large natural disaster.
