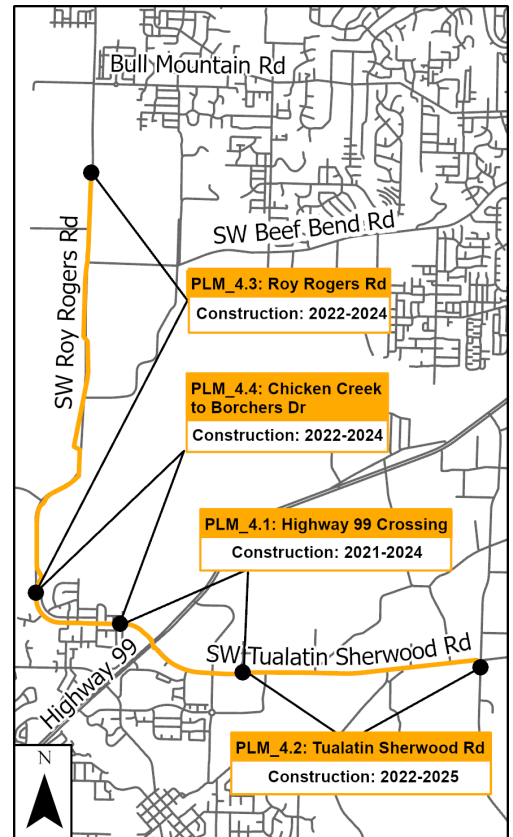
Tualatin Sherwood Area Pipeline Project (PLM_4.0)

The Tualatin-Sherwood Area Pipeline Project is located in southwest Washington County, along Tualatin Sherwood and Roy Rogers roads. This 5.3-mile section of 66-inch pipe connects the future Water Treatment Plant (located near the intersection of SW 124th Avenue and SW Tualatin-Sherwood Road in Sherwood) with the pipeline that leads to the Water Storage Tank on Cooper Mountain.

Current Construction Status

The project is divided into four segments. Some of the construction is occurring in conjunction with Washington County road improvement projects in order to reduce the number of construction projects, thereby reducing impacts to the traveling public and nearby residents and businesses, and to better manage project costs.

- **Tualatin-Sherwood Road, between SW Olds Place and SW Borchers Road (PLM 4.1):** This 4,200 linear foot section is a partnership with Washington County's transportation improvement project, [Tualatin-Sherwood Road and Highway 99W Intersection](#). Pipe was installed using a trenchless crossing of Hwy 99W which prevented a closure during construction. Pipeline installation is complete, with overall project completion anticipated in fall 2024.
- **Tualatin-Sherwood Road, between SW 124th and SW Olds Place (PLM 4.2):** This 7,125 linear foot section includes three trenchless crossings of roads and train tracks, and 700 linear feet of 12-inch pipe replacement for the City of Sherwood. This segment is a joint project with Washington County's transportation improvement project [Tualatin-Sherwood Road \(Langer Farms Parkway to Teton Avenue\)](#). Overall project is approximately 20% complete, and it is anticipated to be complete in summer 2025.
- **Roy Rogers Road, between Chicken Creek and north of Beef Bend Road (PLM 4.3):** This 13,200 linear foot section includes two trenchless crossings beneath the Tualatin River and Chicken Creek. Approximately 50% complete, it is anticipated to be complete in summer 2024.
- **Roy Rogers Road, between Chicken Creek and SW Borchers Drive (PLM 4.4):** This 3,037 linear foot segment is a joint project with Washington County's transportation improvement project [S.W. Roy Rogers Road \(Chicken Creek to S.W. Borchers Drive\)](#). Pipeline installation is complete, with overall project completion anticipated in fall 2024.
