

# Allen Boulevard Final Paving Planned

Recompaction is complete (phase 1) and final paving (phase 2) remains for Allen Boulevard restoration between Scholls Ferry Road and Western Avenue. Weather permitting, final paving is scheduled to begin after mid-March. Road maintenance will continue as needed.

Thank you for your patience with our work.

- A. COMPLETE, Phase 1 Re-compaction—Crews excavated the road base over the pipeline trench areas, placed a specialized geotextile membrane where needed, then compacted the road base and placed pavement on top.
- B. UPCOMING, Phase 2, Repaving—Crews will remove the top layer of the road surface from curb-to-curb, then place a fresh layer of pavement and restripe the road.

Construction will occur mostly during the day (7 am to 4 pm) but may require nightwork (8 pm to 5 am) at certain locations. Expect traffic restrictions and intermittent use of flaggers. Please take extra care when traveling through construction areas and plan extra time into your trips.

## Expect:

- Traffic delays and congestion
- Noise and vibration
- Driveway access will be maintained
- As needed, no left hand turns for traffic entering Allen from connecting driveways
- Bicycle lane closures where vehicles and bicycles will share the road with automobiles
- Intermittent flaggers in use

**The Willamette Water Supply System (WWSS)** is a partnership between the Tualatin Valley Water District (TVWD), City of Hillsboro, and City of Beaverton to build a new seismically resilient drinking water system by 2026. The MPE\_1.0 project combines planned improvements by TVWD and the City of Beaverton water construction projects. The combined project maximizes cost-effectiveness and reduces community and environmental construction impacts. Those living, traveling, working, and shopping along portions of SW Scholls Ferry Road, SW Hall Boulevard, SW Cascade Avenue, SW Allen Boulevard and Western Avenue can expect various construction activities from the fall of 2021 until early 2025.
